## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. What is Reunion?

Reunion is a UNH tradition! Classes celebrating their 60<sup>th</sup>, 55<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and Young Alumni (20<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>) come back to Durham each year to reconnect, reminisce and see what has changed on campus — and how much has stayed the same!

- 60<sup>th</sup>, 55<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, and 40<sup>th</sup> | Celebrate in the spring – typically the first weekend in June
- 25<sup>th</sup> and Young Alumni (20<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>) | Celebrate in the fall – typically Homecoming Weekend

Non-milestone reunion year classes and Common Interest Groups are also encouraged to join in the fun at any time of year. Reunion is whatever you and your UNH friends want it to be!

### 3. Why should I attend reunion?

- To reconnect with old friends and classmates in the place where some of your most memorable experiences took place.
- To laugh! Remember all the crazy things you used to do when your biggest worry was getting to class on time?
- To learn something new from another alum, a current student or a UNH professor. You will be amazed at the innovative stuff going on at your alma mater these days!

4. **Do I have to attend the full weekend?** You can attend one event or the entire weekend. It's completely up to you. You select (and pay for) only those events you wish to attend.

5. **What options are there for accommodations?** You can either stay in a local hotel or guest house of your choosing or you can stay on-campus in the residence hall selected for your class. Basic linens and toiletries are provided, handicap accessible rooms are available, and rooming requests are accepted.

6. **How do I register?** Registration will open in March 2024. Spring reunion registration will be available by mail or [online](#). Fall reunion registration will be [online](#) only.
7. **Are walk-ins accepted?** Pre-registration is appreciated. Walk-in availability is limited at events requiring a registration fee. All walk-ins must first register at the Elliott Alumni Center to confirm availability and pay related event fees. Check the schedule for registration hours.
8. **How much is it to attend reunion?** Many events are free, however if food and beverages are being served there is an associated cost. Prices will be noted on the Schedule of Events next to each event (beginning in early March '24). On-campus housing costs will also listed there. Please note that each reunion attendee will be charged a registration fee. This fee helps the university cover some of the costs associated with hosting reunion, such as tents, rentals, facilities, parking, transportation, materials, and so on. Please know that we do our absolute best to keep costs as low as possible. Thank you for understanding.
9. **How can I find out if my friends are going?** Once registration is open you will be able to search the attendance list from the [reunion homepage](#). We will also post the names of attendees to the Facebook page. Better yet, contact them directly to make sure they will be there!
